

### With Dermalize:

- **Keep bandage for 4-7 days** (the bandage/plaster is waterproof so you can shower with it but don't submerge it in a bathtub), the tattoo will heal much faster and will lose less ink when covered with the bandage.
- **Remove bandage** in the shower slowly **and wash it** with warm water and soap until all the blood and plasma is gone.
- **Dry yourself** as normal and for the **next 3 weeks apply perfume free moisturiser** to the area a couple times a day.
- **After the tattoo is healed**, remember to apply **suncream factor 30 or higher**, anytime you spend time outdoors, otherwise the colour can fade drastically, and the tattoo will not age as gracefully.

### Without Dermalize:

- In case **you think you've developed an allergic reaction** to the bandage (redness, tender to touch, very itchy or developed bumps/pimples inside the bandage or around), remove the bandage and wash with warm water and soap. The reaction will disappear in a few days and the tattoo will be fine!
- If you think you might have **an infection contact your doctor!**
- **If the bandage starts leaking or peels back and the tattoo is exposed** before the 4-7 days, it should be removed immediately.
- **If the plastic wrap was removed before the 7 days time, the tattoo will have to be washed with warm water and perfume free soap daily for the first 2 weeks and you will have to keep it moisturised with panthenol/perfume free cream 4 times a day for 1 month. During this time scabs can also form and start to peel off, it is important that you do not itch or peel the scabs!**

A free retouch is offered in the following 3 months after the tattoo appointment.

Remember that its important to follow the aftercare provided by the artist  
- free retouches can be refused if aftercare was neglected by the customer.
